

## COVID-19 UPDATE June 23, 2020

Okanogan County Public Health is reporting 6 new cases since last Friday (June 19, 2020). The new cases are from Brewster.

## **Okanogan County to Remain in Phase 2**

Okanogan County was approved to move to Phase 2 on June 5<sup>th</sup>. All counties are required to be in each phase for a minimum of 3 weeks. In addition, there are target metrics that counties need to meet.

The Incidence Rate (number or new cases per 100,000 population per 14 days) is a metric that is closely monitored to determine a county's readiness to move to the next phase. The target for this metric is 25 cases / 100,000 people / 14 days. As of today, the Incidence Rate for Okanogan County is 49.1 cases / 100,000 people / 14 days.

## **Facial Coverings will be Mandatory Statewide**

Governor Jay Inslee announced a statewide public health order by Secretary of Health John Wiesman that will require people to wear facial coverings in public settings.

The order requires face coverings when people are indoor in a public area and outdoors in a public area when six feet of physical distancing cannot be maintained. The order goes into effect Friday, June 26.
