FINAL RELEASE

Ellisforde, **WA** - The Swanson Mill Fire ignited at approximately 1:42pm on Wednesday, July 3rd.

--Crews have accurately measured the footprint of the fire and sized it at 281 acres--

Full containment has been achieved and the focus of work now shifts to general rehabilitation and clean up of the site of the fire. We wish to express our sincere appreciation for the support given to our efforts by the community of Oroville and surrounding areas.

<u>Today</u>. Crews will be finalizing mop-up and working to provide rehabilitation in the area of the fire in preparation for transition to local authorities.

The final shift under the Type 3 Incident Management Team is scheduled to end this evening and the fire management transition to the local districts for patrol of the area is scheduled to occur at 1800 hours today (July 6th, 2019).
