INCIDENT SUMMARY

General Situation: On April 23rd we had our first confirmed COVID-19 related fatality in Okanogan County. There are now positive COVID-19 cases in all areas of the County. We continue to provide PPE resources to hospitals, clinics, EMT's, EMS and in-home / long-term care facilities. While our primary focus continues to be actively promoting social distancing and the Governor's "Stay Home-Stay Healthy" order, we are also concentrating efforts on ways to isolate and quarantine potentially infected people, including the homeless, and ways to provision and staff isolation and/or quarantine facilities.

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS FOR REPORTING PERIOD

General / Community:

- 4/30 Okanogan River near Tonasket is at 10.09 ft, forecasted to crest at 11.7 ft on Monday the 4th, flood stage is 15 ft, 19.71 was reached on 5/12/2018.

- 4/30 1330 hrs Reports received of a possible meteor observed high over Twisp, travelling south to north producing a sonic boom. No issues.
- 4/23 First COVID-19 death in Okanogan County
- 4/24 Bureau of Reclamation team conducted a seepage analysis using a water-safe red dye. Another inspection will take place the week of May 4th.
- Lael Duncan with Community Action is completing a long term forecast of estimated food needs and supplies for area food banks.
- 4/17 DNR lifted ban on Permit burns, Rule burns, not to exceed 10 feet in diameter, are allowed.
- 4/24 Schools pushed notice out asking for one person only to pick up lunches from busses, per EOC request.
- 4/23 Resolution <u>51-2020</u> amending overnight transient accommodations (OTA's) from "closed" to "restricted" was posted to Public Health and Emergency Management websites and social media.
- 4/30 Okanogan County PUD No. 1 continues work to deploy 15 "Drive-Fi" hotspots throughout Okanogan County to support local students.

Critical Needs - Alternate Care Facility:

- 4/30 Community Action provided a motel room for person requiring a place to quarantine.
- Two potential alternate care facilities (ACF) are under consideration.
- Ordered 8 hospital beds from State EOC for ACF. Was advised will be delivered 5/1 to Fairgrounds.
- Discussed staffing and other supply needs with State EOC.
- Researching other avenues (nursing students, retirees, volunteers) for facility staffing and security

Critical Needs – Supplies & PPE:

- Public Health received 700 COVID-19 test kits and are distributing them to Health Care facilities.
- There is still a shortage on isolation and surgical gowns, individual hand sanitizer bottles and disinfectant wipes.
- 4/30 Received isolation suits, gloves and alcohol hand sanitizer from State.
- Received 600 cloth masks from eqpd in Twisp.


